2. I acknowledge that the provision of false or misleading information may result in non-acceptance of this application or immediate exclusion from the University, or that the University may vary any decision regarding admission or enrolment made on the basis of incorrect or incomplete information.
3. I authorise Charles Sturt University (CSU) to undertake inquiries regarding my enrolment or study at any educational institutions previously attended by me including collecting personal information about me by obtaining official records or engaging in discussions about me with officials from those educational institutions.
4. I am making this application for the purpose of studying full time at CSU and not for any other purpose.
5. I understand and accept that I must comply with the academic rules and regulations in place at CSU and the laws applicable in Australia at all times and that any failure to do so may result in my exclusion from the University or expulsion from Australia.
6. I clearly understand and accept that enrolment at CSU will require compliance with the provisions established by the Australian Government for overseas students, which include the following:
  - a. *temporary entry to Australia, if granted, will be for study purposes only;*
  - b. *to be accepted to study at CSU I must have at least the minimum academic and English language requirements for the course;*
  - c. *I will be permitted to continue my study in Australia only if I make satisfactory progress in my course and attend all lecturers, tutorials and meet all other course requirements;*
  - d. *I must inform the University of my Australian residential address and telephone number at enrolment and advise the University of any changes to these details immediately while enrolled at the University;*
  - e. *I am to return home on the completion of my study or at the expiration of my temporary entry permit, and I understand that temporary entry as a student confers no right of permanent residence in Australia at and after that date*
7. I undertake to pay the prescribed tuition fee at my home institution for which I am liable as an exchange student.
8. I understand that it is my responsibility to negotiate and obtain approval from my home institution for obtaining academic credit for any subjects completed at CSU.
9. I am aware of the likely living cost of my stay in Australia, and I have the necessary financial capacity to meet such costs for the full duration of my exchange period.
10. I understand that the information I have provided to the University may be made available to Commonwealth and State agencies, pursuant to obligations under the law.
11. If accepted into the exchange program, I expressly consent to CSU providing personal information about me to my home institution at any time including:
  - a. *my results or academic transcript in courses or subjects for which I am enrolled;*
  - b. *if I withdraw from or fail a subject or course;*
  - c. *any complaints or findings of misconduct or inappropriate behaviour made to or by the University about me;*
  - d. *non-attendance at any lecturers or tutorials or non-completion of any course or subject requirements;*
  - e. *information regarding my general health or safety, including reasonable concerns held by the University about my general wellbeing.*

I have obtained and will maintain for the duration of my enrolment with the University adequate health and travel insurance coverage and I agree to indemnify CSU for any expenses, losses, damages and costs that it may sustain or incur as a result, whether directly or indirectly, of any action arising from any failure by myself to obtain or maintain adequate health and travel insurance coverage.
